



MINUTES OF THE 6TH CENTRE-STATE CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE STATE OF GOA HELD ON 05.02.2026

The 6th meeting of the Centre-State Co-ordination Committee for the state of Goa constituted vide Office Order No. 57/2023 dated 06.12.2023 was held in accordance with the directives issued by the GST Council Memorandum dated 19th July 2023. The meeting was held in hybrid mode on 5th February, 2026 at 12:30 Hrs. The meeting was attended by the following members:

2. Agenda Points for discussion: -

- (A) Maintaining, updating and sharing details of field level officers.
- (B) Data sharing on important audit paras and modus operandi detected in audit.
- (C) Making corroborative efforts on the issues pertaining to tax payer facilitation as well as tax payer grievances.
- (D) Coordination in the matter regarding investigation/anti evasion proceedings, so as to ensure that on the same issue, investigation in respect of taxpayers is not undertaken by multiple administrations.
- (E) Any other GST matter deemed fit for coordinated work between Central and State Tax Administrations.

3. At the outset, the nodal officer welcomed all the members present in the meeting and informed the attendees that the primary purpose of the meeting is to foster enhanced co-ordination between officials of the Central Tax and State Tax departments.

4. Thereafter, the above agenda points were taken up for discussion:

(A) Maintaining, updating and sharing details of field level officers.

The Additional Commissioner, CGST Goa as well as the Additional Commissioner, State Tax stated that all changes effected due to promotions, transfers and postings are being regularly shared by both the offices.

(B) Data sharing on important audit paras and modus operandi detected in audit.

The Commissioner, CGST Audit-II, Pune informed that they are maintaining co-ordination with their counterparts at State GST Goa. The Pr. Chief Commissioner, CGST Pune Zone desired to know if all the concerned Audit paras raised during the MCM pertaining to tax payers from Goa are being shared with State GST or not. The Commissioner, CGST Audit-II assured the Pr. Chief Commissioner that henceforth all the audit paras pertaining to Goa jurisdiction

will be shared with State GST. The Additional Commissioner, State GST also stated that they are sharing data with CGST Audit-II Commissionerate.

(C) Making corroborative efforts on the issues pertaining to tax payer facilitation as well as tax payer grievances.

The Pr. Chief Commissioner, CGST Pune Zone acknowledged that both the sides have necessary in-house grievance redressal systems to redress grievances of the taxpayers.

A Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) meeting for the state of Goa for the quarter ending September 2025 was held on 5th February, 2026 wherein 19 members participated. The Commissioner, CGST Goa stated that CGST Commissionerate is conducting Open House Sessions every fortnight wherein tax payers could come forward with any grievance.

(D) Coordination in the matter regarding investigation/anti evasion proceedings, so as to ensure that on the same issue, investigation in respect of taxpayers is not undertaken by multiple administrations.

The Pr. Chief Commissioner, CGST Pune Zone and other members noted that there are currently no instances of such overlap.

(E) Any other GST matter deemed fit for coordinated work between Central and State Tax Administrations.

No other issue was raised by any member.

5. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks delivered by the Nodal officer, Centre-State Coordination Committee, Goa to all the members for their participation, acknowledging the valuable contributions and participation of everyone present in the meeting.
