MINUTES OF THE 7TH CENTRE-STATE CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE STATE OF GOA

Venue: Conference Hall, Office Of The Commissioner Of Central Goods & CX., GOA, 2nd Floor, GST Bhavan, EDC Complex, Plot No. 6, Patto Plaza, Panaji, Goa - 403001.

Date & Time: 18th June 2026 at 11:00 Hrs **Mode:** Hybrid

The 7th meeting of the *Centre-State Co-ordination Committee for the State of Goa* was convened in a hybrid format. The Committee, formally constituted vide the *Office Order No. 57/2023 dated 06.12.2023*, operated in strict accordance with the directives delineated in the GST Council Memorandum dated 19th July 2023.

2. The meeting was chaired by Shri Neeraj Kansal, Chief Commissioner, CGST & Customs, Pune Zone (Chair) and Shri S. S. Gill, Commissioner of State Tax, Goa (Co-Chair)
3. The proceedings were attended by the following members:

4. The meeting commenced with a formal welcome address by the

Commissioner, CGST Goa, greeting all members present and he articulated that the primary objective of the session was to cultivate enhanced coordination between the officials of the Central Tax and State Tax departments.

5. Following this, the Additional Commissioner, CGST Goa, presented the agenda points for discussion, deliberation and decision.

Agenda I. Maintenance, Updating, and Sharing of Field-Level Officer

- a. The Chief Commissioner and the Co-Chair, underscored the necessity of periodically sharing updated rosters of field-level officers between the Central and State Tax administrations to foster optimal coordination and communication at the grassroots level.
- b. It was noted by the committee that officer details are typically exchanged post the Annual General Transfer (AGT).
- c. It was formally resolved that updated officer details shall be consistently and regularly shared between both administrations to fortify coordination and guarantee efficacious information exchange.

Agenda II. Data Sharing Regarding Crucial Audit Paras and Identified Modus Operandi

- a. Commissioner, State Tax, Goa, elucidated the critical importance of disseminating significant audit observations and modus operandi uncovered during audits, expressly noting the limited exposure of State officers.
- b. Commissioner, CGST Audit-II, Pune, apprised the committee of the robust, ongoing coordination maintained with their State GST counterparts in Goa.
- c. It was unequivocally decided that pertinent audit paras and modus operandi identified during audits will be routinely shared with both the Chief Commissioner, CGST Pune Zone, and the Commissioner of State Tax, Goa, to ensure necessary dissemination and subsequent follow-up actions.

Agenda III. Collaborative Efforts in Taxpayer Facilitation and Grievance Redressal

- a. The committee acknowledged that both tax administrations possess established, in-house grievance redressal mechanisms dedicated to addressing taxpayer concerns.
- b. It was noted that a Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) meeting for the State of Goa was previously convened on 18th February 2026.
- c. Furthermore, the Commissioner, CGST Goa, reported that the CGST Commissionerate successfully hosted a "*Samvad Session*" on 22nd May 2026, providing an open platform for taxpayers to present their grievances.

Agenda IV. Coordination in Investigation and Anti-Evasion Proceedings

- a. Deliberations focused on harmonizing investigation and anti-evasion protocols to preclude investigative duplication across multiple administrations on identical matters, thereby ensuring potent enforcement. The committee observed that regular coordination assemblies and the prompt exchange of intelligence are imperative to forestall overlapping investigations and enable decisive action against evaders.
- b. Both departments reaffirmed their steadfast commitment to intelligence sharing and maintaining consistent communication regarding active cases of tax evasion.
- c. To effectuate this operational synergy, the Chief Commissioner, Pune Zone, recommended the institution of monthly coordination and information-sharing meetings encompassing officers from both Central and State GST.

Agenda V. Miscellaneous GST Matters for Coordinated Action

No supplementary issues were brought forth for deliberation by the members.

6. The proceedings concluded with a formal vote of thanks rendered by the Nodal Officer of the Centre-State Coordination Committee, Goa.
